#### **Meditation and Yoga**

Add meditation/yoga to your school's routine through study halls, advisory periods and after school time.



#### School Instagram Account

Create a school or class Instagram account to share news, student stories and weekly school happenings.



#### **Supporting Sports**

Organize at least one match/game for each athletic team where you try to get high attendance.



#### **Peace Room**

Create a peace room for students to use to take breaks and relax.



#### **Book Swap**

Coordinate a school-wide book swap where students and teachers share their favorite books with a note describing the significance each book holds for them.



#### Big Sib, Little Sib

Start a big brother/ big sister program that matches incoming freshmen with seniors.



#### **Language Lunch**

Start a language table at lunch to give students more opportunities to speak foreign languages (e.g. Spanish table, French table, Chinese table, etc.).



#### Interest-based Mentorship

Start a mentorship program at your school where students and teachers are matched by interest (e.g. guitar, cooking, etc.).



#### **Speak Love**

Start a movement to reduce bias, rumorspreading, negativity and derogatory language.



#### Pause Bell

Set up a bell on the loudspeaker in your school that goes off a few times a day. Every time the bell rings, everyone must stop what they are doing and take three deep breaths.



## Student-to-Student **Mentoring Program**

Start a program at your school for mentoring or tutoring elementary school children.



#### **Journal Swap**

Coordinate pairs of students (even those who might not already know each other) to write in journals each week/month, and then non-judgmentally share with each other, without comments or criticism.
